The axe is named after the nearby lake, Ågelsjön, where the water needed to run the waterwheel for the forge was once taken.

Like all our axes, the Ågelsjön is hand forged and made from Swedish recycled CO₂ neutral steel. The wooden handle is made from American hickory, treated with linseed oil. The leather axe sheath is made in Sweden, from Swedish certified leather.



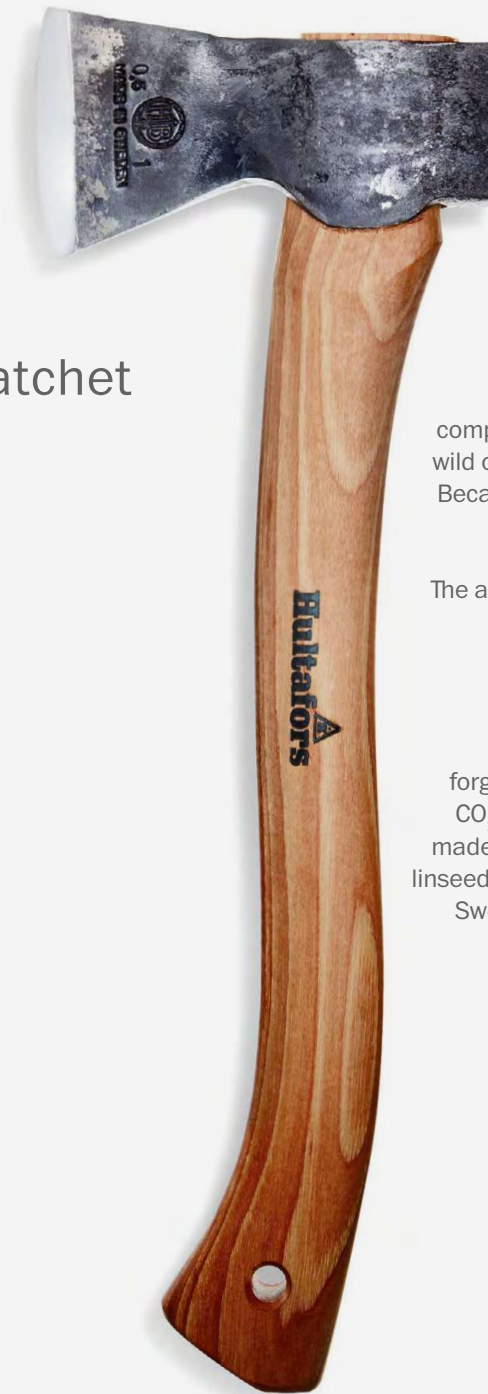

The axe is named after Hultån, the stream which once provided the forge with power. Today Hultån runs through a tunnel underneath Hults Bruk.

Like all our axes, the Hultån is hand forged and made from Swedish recycled CO₂ neutral steel. The wooden handle is made from American hickory, treated with linseed oil. The leather axe sheath is made in Sweden, from Swedish certified leather.



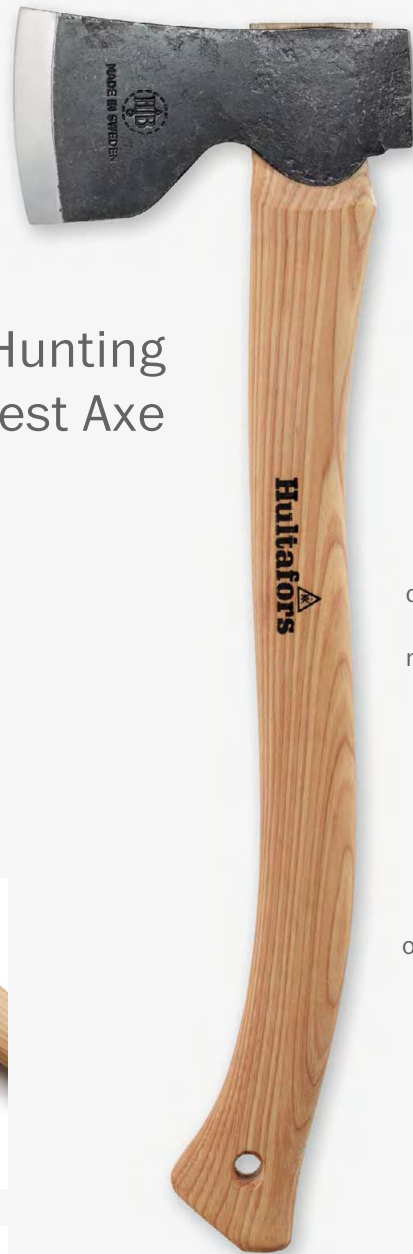

Dvardala Hunting & Forest Axe



The Dvardala is a perfect axe for hunting and forest life. It has the same hybrid head as our Åby Forest Axe. It is a combination of several different axe types, ideal for a day in the forest where you might have to deal with a wide range of challenges.

The short handle is slightly thicker and more curved with a little bigger end knob than the other premium axes. The handle length also makes it easier to bring with you, for example in a backpack. It also makes it easier when you work with the axe close to the body. The axe is suitable for precision work such as carving or building shelters, fire stands and other things around hunting and forest life.

The axe is named after Dvardala, which is an old name for the forest area just north of Hults Bruk. This is where Kolmårdern forest begins, known for good hunting.

Like all our axes, the Dvardala is hand forged and made from Swedish recycled CO₂ neutral steel. The wooden handle is made from American hickory, treated with linseed oil. The leather axe sheath is made in Sweden, from Swedish certified leather.

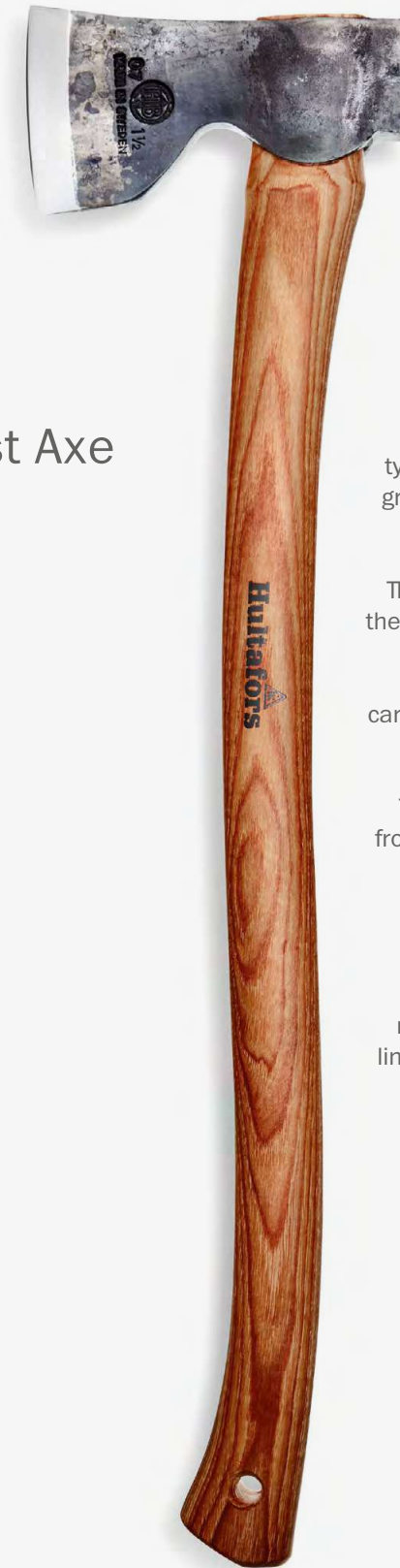

Åby Forest Axe



The Åby is a beautiful hybrid with many types of use. Åby has a straighter edge and grinding, and a good finger notch below the head for increased precision.

The long, thin ergonomic handle minimizes the weight, at the same time giving you great force when striking. This axe is perfect for shelter building, processing firewood and carving, as well as precision work. In short, it is your perfect forest companion.

The axe is named after the nearest village from Hults Bruk, where many of the workers at the forge lived in the mid 20th century.

Like all our axes, the Åby is hand forged and made from Swedish recycled CO₂ neutral steel. The wooden handle is made from American hickory, treated with linseed oil. The leather axe sheath is made in Sweden, from Swedish certified leather.

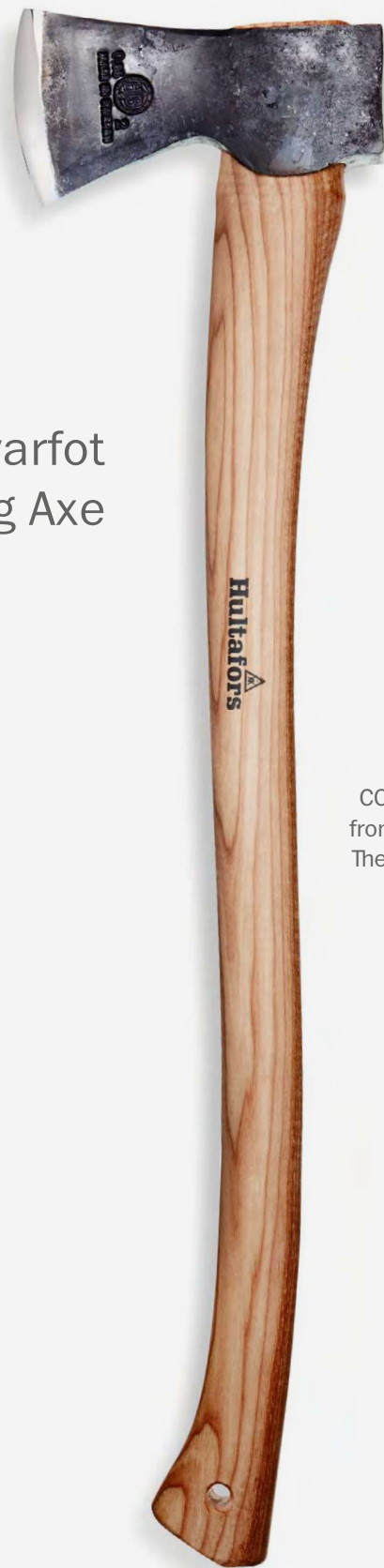

Qvarfot Felling Axe



The Qvarfot is an axe well suited to assist you in small scale forestry. The long handle adds force to the striking action and the axe is also useful for splitting, bucking and processing wood.

The axe is named after one of the families who served as blacksmiths at Hults Bruk for generations, the Qvarfots.

Like all our axes, the Qvarfot is hand forged and made from Swedish recycled CO₂ neutral steel. The wooden handle is made from American hickory, treated with linseed oil. The leather axe sheath is made in Sweden, from Swedish certified leather.

Ekelund Small Felling Axe



The Ekelund is a smaller felling axe with the same head as Qvarfot, but the handle is shorter which makes it more mobile and easy to carry.

The axe is named after Gunnar Ekelund, the owner of Hults Bruk who decided to produce axes in modern way at a larger scale in 1870-75.

Like all our axes, the Ekelund is hand forged and made from Swedish recycled CO₂ neutral steel. The wooden handle is made from American hickory, treated with linseed oil. The leather axe sheath is made in Sweden, from Swedish certified leather.



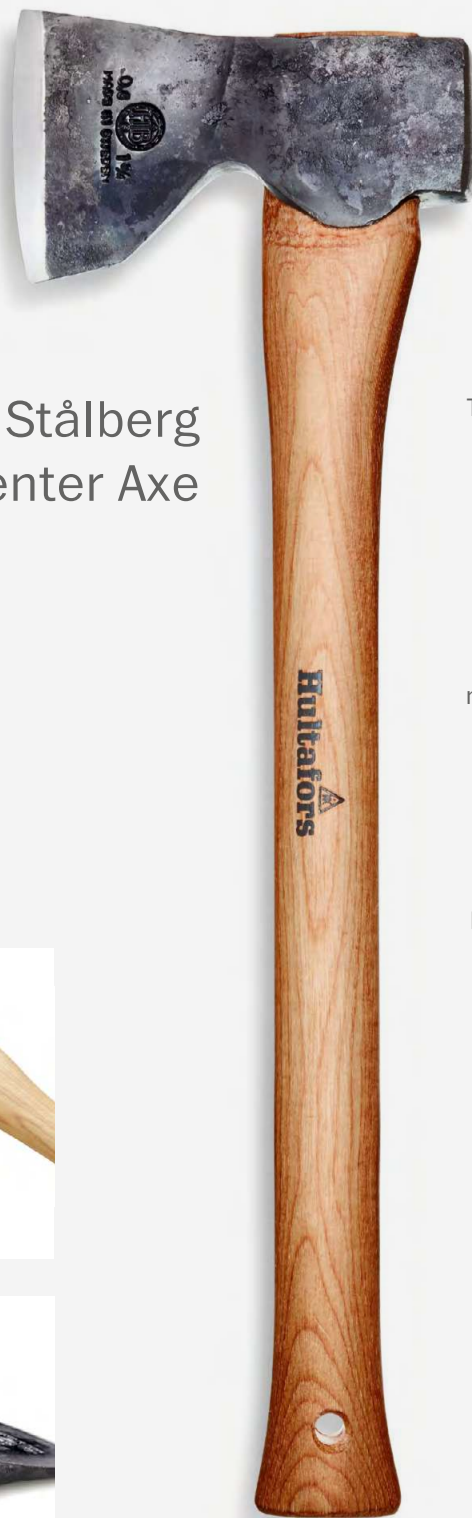

Stålberg Carpenter Axe



The Stålberg has a straight handle and long, narrow and straight edge. It will provide you with the precision any skilled craftsman needs. The finger notch in the axe head allows a grip where your hand is placed, almost straight above the center of the cutting edge, for increased precision.

The axe is named after one of Hults Bruk's most experienced blacksmiths from the first half of the 20th century, Ernst Stålberg.

Like all our axes, the Stålberg is hand forged and made from Swedish recycled CO₂ neutral steel. The wooden handle is made from American hickory, treated with linseed oil. The leather axe sheath is made in Sweden, from Swedish certified leather.

Hult Splitting Axe



The Hult is a solid splitting axe, intended for heavier duties such as splitting logs and wood. The shape of the head, combined with slightly convex grinding, splits the wood. The Hult axe has a long and straight handle to gain maximum speed and control when splitting logs.

The axe is named after Hult, the area where Hults Bruk was founded. Like most old Swedish geographical names, it describes the surrounding landscape of the place.

Like all our axes, the Hult is hand forged and made from Swedish recycled CO₂ neutral steel. The wooden handle is made from American hickory, treated with linseed oil. The leather axe sheath is made in Sweden, from Swedish certified leather.



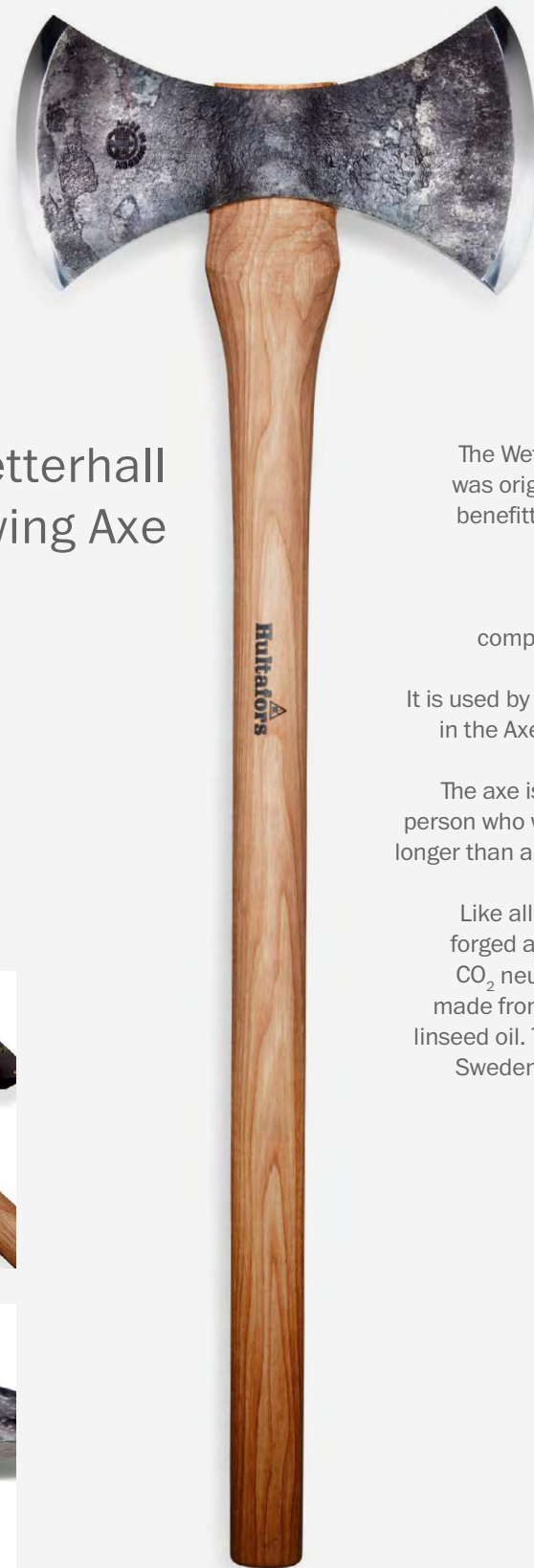

Wetterhall Throwing Axe



The Wetterhall is a double bit axe which was originally used by lumberjacks, who benefitted from the possibility of always having a sharp axe around.

Today it is used for axe throwing competitions and designed according to the axe throwing regulations. It is used by some of the axe throwing teams in the Axe Throwing World Championship.

The axe is named after Bo Wetterhall, the person who worked and served at Hults bruk longer than anyone else, more than 50 years.

Like all our axes, the Wetterhall is hand forged and made from Swedish recycled CO₂ neutral steel. The wooden handle is made from American hickory, treated with linseed oil. The leather axe sheath is made in Sweden, from Swedish certified leather.

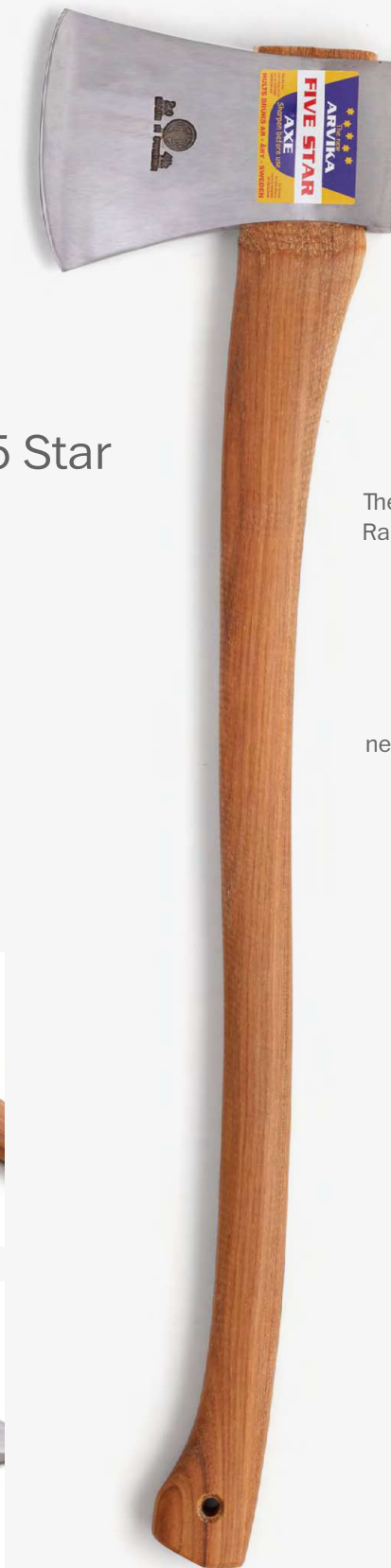

The Arvika is a large felling axe designed for competition and serious chopping. The design of the head is inspired by Australian Racing Pattern Axes, polished and heavy with a convex grind edge. The long and curved handle provides maximum speed and force when felling trees.

Like all our axes, the Arvika is hand forged and made from Swedish recycled CO₂ neutral steel. The wooden handle is made from American hickory, treated with linseed oil.

Axe sheaths and leather accessories

We are proud to be able to say that our axes are among the best available and when we developed new axe sheaths and accessories, we had just as high ambitions in terms of both quality and environmental considerations.



Made in Sweden

Our premium axe sheaths are sewn from full-grain leather – a leather where all layers of the animal skin are used. It produces a thick, durable leather that acquires a fine patina over time. All leather comes from cows that are raised on a number of selected farms north of Siljan in Dalarna. The cows are mainly kept for the sake of the meat and the leather is a grateful by-product of the meat production.

We have not only chosen Swedish leather because of the proximity, but mainly because Sweden has very high requirements for animal husbandry,

The axe sheaths are cut and sewn in Sweden. And even in the last phase of production, sustainability work continues with a focus on, among other things, reduced material waste and energy from renewable sources. They have ambitious work to reduce material waste and between 2020 and 2021 they managed to reduce material waste by 14%. Our supplier also works with social aspects of sustainability and works to arrange employment for people who otherwise have difficulty finding a place on the labor market.

Certified leather

Our supplier of axe sheaths is third-party audited every year by HIGG. The supply chain is tested against the requirements in IWAY 6, which is IKEA's system for creating a sustainable value chain.

The products are also tested and evaluated by accredited labs such as Buro veritas. Tanneries used have LWG certification, which means that their production is reviewed and approved from an environmental perspective. They have control over energy consumption and waste water management, and to have control over chemical use, all chemicals are registered in a portal, ZDHC (Zero Discharge Hazardous Chemicals).

Vegetable tanning

Tanning is a craft almost as old as ax making and our leather is vegetable tanned at LWG certified tanneries near Florence in Italy. There has been incredibly good knowledge, tradition and craftsmanship for vegetable tanning here since ancient times.



Leather Belt

A timeless belt made of vegetable-tanned leather that matches Hults Bruk's premium axe sheaths and other axe accessories. It is 40 mm wide and has a sturdy buckle with an antique brass finish. You can choose between two lengths, 95 and 115 cm. You can unscrew the buckle from the strap and shorten the belt to any length (don't forget to fasten the seam if you do this).

The belt is made in Sweden with hides from Swedish cows and it is manufactured with the greatest care for the animals and the environment. The leather is vegetable tanned full grain leather for the best possible durability and the natural treatment means that it will age beautifully when worn.

Overstrike Guard

A leather strike guard that protects the handle closest to the axe head in the event of an overstrike. The guard (also known as a handle protector or an axe collar) is tied around the handle using the included leather cords.

The strike guard is made in Sweden with hides from Swedish cows and it is manufactured with the greatest care for the animals and the environment. The leather is vegetable tanned full grain leather for the best possible durability and the natural treatment means that it will age beautifully when worn.

The leather is vegetable tanned full grain leather for the best possible durability and the natural treatment means that it will age beautifully when worn.

Axe Sling

A leather axe sling for carrying your axe on your back, perfect when you don't want to carry a backpack. It is length adjustable between 900 and 1100 mm to suit different axes and people. The sling is extra wide over the shoulder to distribute the weight and be comfortable to wear. It attaches to the axe with the carabiners at each end of the sling. One end attaches to the hole in the handle via an extra leather strap that is included, the other end is attached to the axe sheath. (There are only attachment holes on newer sheaths.)

The sling is made in Sweden with hides from Swedish cows and it is manufactured with the greatest care for the animals and the environment. The leather is vegetable tanned full grain leather for the best possible durability and the natural treatment means that it will age beautifully when worn.

In the outdoors, you need to be able to get the fire going, regardless of weather. This fire steel offers great function and ergonomics, resulting in better efficiency. The sparks generated reach approximately 3000°C. To create a spark, the fire steel can be used against the spine of OK1 and OK4, both of which have holsters equipped with a fire steel holder.

Our heavy duty Outdoor Knives are perfect for rough duties in the wild. The cutting edge has a Scandinavian grind for ultimate long-lasting sharpness and is also easy to re-sharpen. Thanks to the 82 mm tang inside the handle, both knives are suitable for batoning. The grinded spine of the blade is designed for starting a fire with a fire steel. To withstand rust and corrosion, the blade has a protective electrophoretic deposition coating (EPD), as well as an engraved scale. Fire Steel FS is sold separately.

With our grinding stone you can easily and securely grind your axe wherever you are. The grinding stone is of good size and designed to give a steady grip, protecting fingers and hands from cutting injuries. The elegant case in genuine leather protects your grinding stone, rendering it a long life. The rough side has a grain size of 180, and the fine side a grain size of 600, which is a good combination to regain sharpness to your axe. To make your work easier, we would recommend that you grind with water.

From the Hult Valley to Countries Around the World

Hults Bruk was originally founded in 1697 in the Hult Valley in southeastern Sweden. Forging by hand began with nails for shipbuilding and making iron bars. Later came the forging of metal sheets, anchor chains and castings followed by hand tools such as axes and spades used by farmers in the region for work in the forests and in the fields.

By 1870 axes had become a major part of Hults Bruk's production. The then owner, an ironmaster named Ekelund, bought two new axe forging machines in 1877 to meet the demand.

The end of the Nineteenth century was a turbulent period in Sweden. The Industrial Revolution brought changes across Europe. As a result of major developments in all facets of society, more energy was needed. The increased importance of forestry and the cutting down of trees created the need for many more axes.

Today Hults Bruk is a combination of the new and the old but our basic culture has not changed over the years. The striving of each individual blacksmith to always do his very best while relying on a time honoured tradition has resulted in Hultafors axes being famous throughout the world.
